Year	Accomplishments	Goals
2000	10 one-year college scholarships.	Rather than general donations, focus on yearly sponsors.
2001	50 one-year college scholarships.	Provide scholarships to students at 3 all-girls high schools.
2002	80 one-year college scholarships. 30 one-year high school scholarships.	Visit Zambia once a year to check on students.
2003	100 one-year college scholarships. 60 one-year high school scholarships.	Provide scholarships to boys who want to attend high school.
2004	120 one-year college scholarships. 80 one-year high school scholarships.	Create an <i>Adopt a School</i> program, which offers jobs to teachers in rural community schools.
2005	80 one-year college scholarships. 90 one-year high school scholarships. 1 adopted school (Chabala village).	Increase the <i>Adopt a School</i> program. Ship a 40' container of used textbooks to all schools on the program.
2006	76 one-year college scholarships. 131 one-year high school scholarships. 20 elementary schools on our <i>Adopt a School</i> program. Sent one 40' container of used textbooks to Zambia.	Increase current programs.
2007	121 college scholarships. 213 high school scholarships. 45 adopted schools. Sent one 40' container of supplies to Zambia.	Donate one computer to each school in our program. Ten high schools and three teacher's colleges. Increase current programs.
2008	104 college scholarships. 185 high school scholarships. 50 adopted schools. Sent two 40' containers of books and supplies. Delivered 13 computers monitors, printers, and software.	Check on computers, books and supplies to see how they have been used. Increase current program. Purchase a used vehicle to deliver supplies to schools. Hire employees in Zambia. Set up an office in Kasama.
2009	110 college scholarships. 164 high school scholarships. 60 adopted schools. Sent one 40' container of supplies. Purchased a used Toyota Land Cruiser.	Set up an office in Kasama. Increase adopted schools. Take entire board of trustees to Zambia to visit all sponsored schools.
2010	75 college scholarships. 229 high school scholarships. 62 adopted schools. Visited all schools and school districts on the program.	Purchase Bicycles for all our adopted schools. Add trade colleges for high school students that don't qualify to become teachers.
2011	64 adopted schools. 75 college teaching scholarships 4 trade school students. 230 high school scholarships. Delivered chalkboards to the schools that did not have one. Delivered 62 Bicycles (one for every teacher at each adopted school)	Provide first aid kits, hygiene kits, chalkboards, mattresses, etc. for our " <i>Adopt a School teaches</i> ". Open 3 new branches of ZSF in California, Washington DC and South Carolina. Send one 40' container of supplies.
